Community Congregational Preschool

Thank you for your continual support of the staff, children and, our school program as we face this Pandemic together. Our goal is to follow State Mandates, and Childcare licensing guidelines that ensure the safety of our families, children and staff, while still providing our quality preschool program.

Hours of Operation

Full time: 8:00am to 5:00pm or 9:00am to 4:00pm

Morning: 9:00am -12:00noon or 9:00am to 1:00pm

Afternoon: 12:00noon to 4:00pm or 1:00pm to 5:00pm

Drop off and Pick up

Drop off will be at the preschool entrance by the gates, off Center street. Sign in sheets will be located at the entrance. Adults dropping off and or picking up must wear masks, social distance, and may not enter the classroom. All children will have a temperature reading before a staff member will escort the children inside to wash their hands before entering the classroom.

Pick up will be located at the same place and children will be taken out to the adult whom is picking up. Please call the preschool office if you have a different pick up time than designated. @ 619 420-2046.

Everyone entering the facility will need to wear a mask, however students and staff are not required per CDC guidelines. We will encourage children to wear them so please have your child bring one to school. The staff will be using masks when need and at appropriate times.

Extra Clothing

Parents are to bring extra clothing in a zip lock bag with name on it to leave in your child's cubby. Please do not have your child bring a back pack or toys to school. We would however request that each child bring their own water bottle marked with their name on it.

Class room size

The class room size has been decreased to 10 students per class with 2 to 3 teachers. This is due to the CDC orders and will continue until we are in stage 3. We will increase class size as we gain knowledge on how to remain in compliance with the new order set forth by CDC & CCL.

Classroom Design

Each class will have 2 rooms that they will be able to utilize throughout the day. We will create more centers so children can explore, play and learn. Our plan is to sanitize and hand wash between play. Sanitization station are hung up in each room for convenience. The Church has hired a sanitization company that is coming in weekly to deep clean along with our daily cleaning.

Outdoor shovels, trucks, toys will not be shared and be used by individual classrooms by having their own tubs, then cleaned at the end of the day. Outdoor time will be on a rotation and large toys such as slide, climbing, and play house will be sprayed down between classes.

Snack and Lunch

Teachers will be serving snack to children while wearing gloves, we will not be having a family style at this time. Children will be spaced out at tables, yet can still enjoy conversation. Please have your child bring lunch to school if they stay for the lunch hour. After lunch all tables will be sanitized and children will continue on with the day in their group.

Bathroom Time

Each classroom has their own bathroom located in their building. Children will be escorted one by one to use the facilities., wash hands ext.

Nap Time

If your child stays for and is a napper, they will do so in their own classroom. Cots will be Head to Toe and spaced out 6 to 10 feet apart. Children can bring a blanket or personal item but it must stay at school and be sent home at the end of the week.

Health Guidelines

To ensure a healthy environment we will enforce a daily inspection of a temperature reading.

STAY HOME IF

A fever of 100 or higher or had a fever during the last 72 hours.

Has heavy nasal discharge or cough.

Is over tired

Has vomited or had diarrhea in the past 72 hours.

Has been exposed to a communicable disease and may be developing symptoms

Has symptoms of runny nose, sore throat, headache, abdominal pain, redness in or discharge from eyes, and or fever.

Your child will be sent home if symptoms of illness appear. They will be isolated, and you will be called to pick them up from school within 15 minutes. Your child will not be able to return to school until 72 hours fever free and symptoms are no longer present.

We must report any exposure to COVID -19 to CDC and CCL.
