How Mother's Day Began:

Rev. Victoria

At a memorial service for her mother, May 19, 1908, Anna M. Jarvis, gave her mother's favorite flower, a carnation, to each person attending. Within the next few years the idea to honor mothers gained popularity. Soon Mother's Day was observed in a number of American cities. Then on May 9, 1914, by an act of Congress, President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day. By then it had become customary to wear a white carnation honoring departed mothers, and a red carnation to honor living mothers.
